Parents are requested not to send their ward early to school in view of their safety, as the school can not provide 'Adult Supervision' before the school hours.

BEYOND CURRICULUM

Intensive coaching will be provided to the students by the experienced faculties to prepare them for **IAPT, Mathematics, Science & different Olympiads. JEE / Medical** coaching for **Std-IX to XII** students will be extended beyond the school hours.

EXAMINATION & PROMOTION RULES

1. (a) Promotion is based on the day-to-day performance of the students throughout the year and also on the performance in the Chapter End Test, Half Yearly & Annual Test.
(b) Attendance, Sincerity, Aptitude and Behaviour will be assessed and graded comprehensively.
2. Health and Physical education and Work Experience are important subjects. So detention, in these subjects will lead to total detention in the class.
3. Attendance in all the tests is compulsory. Any absence from the Test should be substantiated with valid reasons
4. Students of Std-XI & XII should secure a minimum of 33% marks, in each subject(in theory & practical separately) in the Half Yearly Examination and 75% attendance to be eligible for filling up forms for Board examination.
5. Result once declared by the Academic Committee shall be final and binding to all.
6. In order to get promotion to the next higher class:
 - a. A student has to secure 33% in theory of each subject and 33% in aggregate.
 - b. It is compulsory to appear all the tests.
 - c. Minimum attendance required is 75%. This is in accordance with the CBSE Examination Bye-Laws.
 - d. Absent in any examination will result in 0 weightage



Facilities Extended

Resource Centre : A4000 sq.ft. open reading centre with 14000 books and journals of National and international repute and journal, Web Resource Centre is the focal point & nerve centre of the students. The provision has been made for students to view digitalised books.

Computer Wing : Two full-fledged computer labs with Broad-band connection consisting of more than 200 Core-i-3 processor computers along with 18.5" TFT LED Monitors are housed. The systems having multimedia and internet facilities enhance the effectiveness of learning. The School also has provision of online UPS to facilitate the online examinations.

Audio Visual Accessories : The existence of Smart Class Room having projectors, increase the meaningful reference and means of entertainment.

Auditorium : A 1000 seated well furnished auditorium with modern lighting and Dolby digital sound system cater to the needs of the school in curricular and extra curricular activities, like motivational classes and seminars. It also provides scope to observe small functions smoothly.

Laboratories : Three well equipped state-of-the-art laboratories for Science (Physics, Chemistry & Biology), ATL Tinkering Lab, Mathematics Lab, S. St Lab, a fun – filled Kid's Den , a large well equipped Audio Visual Room along with 3 Activity Rooms are the centres of progressive learning.

The Multimedia Room : In order to facilitate the use of technology in teaching-learning process the school has itself become a multimedia resource centre. All the classes are equipped with TATA Class Edge interactive boards. The teachers are well trained with the use of the smart Boards. The Techno friendly e-learning programme by TATAClass Edge for all the classes enriches the intellectual growth and paves for self –paced learning.

Life Skills- The Art Of Living : Learning the facts help a child in becoming knowledgeable, but acquiring the life skills helps a child in becoming ready for life. Along with learning curricular details and Socio-Scientific facts children develop a productive and positive approach towards the society and various situations of life. The training in life skills generate a problem solving approach in the students. It helps in promoting a better personality. The children are groomed with the challenges from real life situations with the help of various clubs, house councils and assemblies.

Fitness, Health & Hygiene : The physical health of the students is our utmost concern. Their physical well being is taken care of in the periodic check-up by qualified doctors and staff nurse. The parents are informed about their wards' health. The physical well being is maintained and enhanced through rigorous training in sports and games. Discipline and sportsmanship is inculcated for life in the sports grounds here in school. Teamwork, co operation and a true sporting spirit is inculcated in the students through various sporting activities. 2 Acres school field has a basketball, volleyball and badminton court. The school also provides special coaching facility for Chess and Table Tennis besides yoga which is also taught to our students.



Lift Facility : The school building is equipped with 2 elevators (1 each in 'A' & 'D' wing) for the smooth commutation of the staff, visitors and needy students.

School Canteen : The School Canteen is well equipped to provide hygienic food.

Clubs : Ten clubs named Readers Club, Eco Club, Health & Wellness Club, Cultural Pantheon, Cyber Hub, Heritage, Interact and Integrity, Financial Literacy Club and Quizzards under the guidance of a teacher President and Student Secretary are vibrantly catering to the development of personality and leadership qualities.

Outing & Excursions : We believe in teaching while demonstrating and learning while doing. So we organise educational excursions and outings to sensitize our students about the real world and to give them a break from the traditional classroom teaching. As nature is the best teacher, we help our children in feeling the beauty of nature from a very close proximity with an adage skill is in our DNA.

Career Counselling : The school hosts regular Career Counselling talks, seminars and interaction with professionals from diverse fields to amplify students responses to contemporary professional needs. Regular and continuous monitoring is provided by the Career Counsellor.

Parent-Teacher Meeting : Parent Teacher Meetings are held regularly to update on the performance of their wards and to strengthen the bond between the school and the guardians. The School has also introduced SMS which stands for instant and hassle-free communication between the school and parents.

Workshops and Seminars : With a view to encourage introspection and to stress upon how an educator needs to be a co-learner, a motivator, a facilitator and not a sole harbinger of wisdom and

knowledge, a number of Capacity-building programmes are conducted to keep the staff and students updated on recent trends in education.

Community Awareness Programme

: The school carries out other social works like sapling plantation, cleaning of nearby slums and to distribute food & clothings in the areas often affected by natural calamities. As per Right to Education Act, the school has reserved 25 per cent seats for the children of economically weaker sections to bring them into the mainstream. This is also in keeping with the DAV tradition of service to society and the nation.

GUIDELINES FOR REGISTRATION INTO LKG

1 REGISTRATION :

- (a) Registration of Disadvantage group of weaker section candidates can be done at the **Govt. Portal www.rteparadarshi.odisha.gov.in** in free of cost, at the time of advertisement published in local newspapers.
- (b) Applicants other than the Special category can get the online Registration Form on payment of Rs. 1,000/- through Debit Card/Credit Card/Net Banking.
- (c) Registration Form duly filled in should be submitted along with the required documents and certificates as mentioned in the form, by the stipulated date. Filled in Registration form without supporting documents will not be entertained.
- (d) Children who are born between 01 April 2019 and 31st March 2020(both days inclusive) for LKG are only eligible for registration to the academic session 2024-25.
- (e) Registration fee is not refundable.
- (f) Every year, we have more applicants than number of seats available. Therefore, if a candidate is unable to secure a seat, it is in no way a reflection of his/her caliber.
- (g) If the number of Registration forms will be more than the number of seats available, in a particular category, random selection procedure will be followed for admission into entry class i.e. L.K.G.

The children will be admitted through Random Selection (Draw of lots). (3) Birth Certificate in Original from the Competent Authority is essential at the time of admission for verification. (4) Aadhaar No. is essential for admission. (5) Presence of parents (Father & Mother both) is essential at the time of admission. (6) The name of the child and the date of birth reflected in Birth Certificate will be entered in the school's admission register and will not be changed further.

GUIDELINES FOR REGISTRATION INTO CLASSES UKG-IX

- 1. Online registration of application form** for admission / into UKG will be open as per the availability of vacancy on payment Rs. 1,000/-.
 - Registration forms for admission into the classes other than UKG can be obtained from the school office as per the availability of vacancy on cash/online payment of Rs.1,000/- after notification for the purpose.
 - There will be an Interactive Session/Aptitude Test for students seeking admission into Class - UKG onwards.
 - The names of the successful candidates will be displayed on the notice board on the dates intimated.
 - Registration fee is not refundable and registration does not guarantee admission.
 - For Class –II and above students transfer from a CBSE affiliated school must submit the Transfer certificate issued from the previous school mentioning the CBSE affiliation number on it. The name of the school must have on the Board's website as an affiliated school.
 - In case of students transfer from a school recognized by/affiliated to any other recognized Board(except CBSE) the School Leaving Certificate must be countersigned by the concerned State Education Authority.
 - No students from disaffiliated or unrecognized schools can be allowed to take admission in this institution.
 - Fees have to be deposited within the stipulated dates, failing which the seat will be allotted to the next waitlisted candidate.
 - The names once entered on the school Rolls, the date of birth shown on the admission form, birth certificate or on the T.C. will not be altered as per the guidelines of the CBSE.

- Successful candidates whose names are included in the list must pay the fees by the dates indicated on the list, displayed on the school notice board otherwise admission will automatically stand cancelled.
 - The Photocopy of Birth Certificate in original issued by the Competent Authority is to be attached with the admission form for classes UKG & Std-I.

GUIDELINES FOR REGISTRATION & PROVISIONAL ADMISSION INTO CLASS XI (OUTSIDE STUDENTS)

- There shall be 4 series of questions viz. (A, B, C & D) & each question has exactly one correct answer which carries 4 marks.
- 1 mark will be deducted for every wrong answer / over writing / scratching / multiple answer.
- After the publication of the Result of DAT, counseling and provisional admission will be held in the school premises.
 - The parents have to give an undertaking that the School Authorities can take any action against their ward in case of showing dismal performance in three consecutive tests conducted by the school meant for continuous & comprehensive evaluation. (either surprise test or terminal test or both).
 - In order to ensure a better examination oriented preparation, it is to be strictly followed that the student have a minimum of 90% attendance in theory and 90% attendance in practical.

4. On the date of provisional admission/ counseling the following are necessary.
 - a. Presence of parents.
 - b. The details of Admission Fee (which will be notified at the time of publication of result).
 - c. Absence in counselling will lead to forfeiture of a claim for admission.
 5. On the date of final admission the following documents are necessary after the publication of Board Result.
 - a. Original along with Attested Photocopy of Mark Sheet & Pass Certificate of the Qualifying Board Examination.
 - b. Original TC / School Leaving Certificate of the previous school.
 - c. Original conduct certificate from the concerned institution last attended.
 - d. Original Migration Certificate from the concerned Board.
- N.B: In case of failure to take final admission the provisional admission shall stand cancelled automatically and no fee will be refunded.

WITHDRAWAL RULES

1. Application for withdrawal is to be made in a prescribed proforma available in the school office. No child can be withdrawn till a written request from parents is put up.
2. One month's notice period is required for withdrawal.
3. Clearance must be obtained from the laboratory, library, sports in charges before applying for withdrawal. Transfer Certificate will be issued after 15 days of the receipt of the application and clearance of all dues.

NON-REFUND OF FEES

Fees once paid is not refundable for any reason whatsoever.

TRANSPORT FACILITY

1. Request for using the bus must be made at the beginning of the session i.e. in March. No request will be entertained during the mid-session.
2. Existing routes will continue to ply. Changes in routes and bus stops will not be entertained during the session.
3. It will be the sole responsibility of the parents to escort the pupil to and from the fixed bus stops. The bus facility is extended at the sole risk and responsibility of the parents.
4. Any suggestions or complaints should be reported to the transport in charge. Parents are expected to treat the bus staff kindly.

1. School fees can only be paid online by means of Debit Card / Credit Card / Net Banking by browsing our school **website-www.davpkt.org.in** or login the payment APP.
2. Transport fee is fixed and charged for the whole year irrespective of distance. Discontinuation of Transport in mid-session will not be permitted.
3. Any fee concession or scholarship granted to the student shall be liable to be withdrawn for misconduct, irregular attendance or failure to maintain scholastic standards
4. The School Leaving Certificate and Periodic Progress Report will not be issued until all the dues that period is cleared. A duplicate copy of each certificate is issued after verification on payment of due charges for Duplicate copy.
